

What to bring to school:

- Plain black socks (long), black marching shoes, athletic shorts (for under uniform), show shirt, gloves, hair clips/ties, sunglasses
- Instrument / flip folder / lyre
- Water bottle

Responsibilities:

“B” Field Rehearsal

- Wear athletic shorts, long black socks, marching shoes, and sunglasses (you will be facing directly at the evening sun).
- Bring your coordinate sheet, show music, and drill team music.
- Bring water.
- Rehearsal starts at 4:25. Allow time to get to the B-field. You will have to move with urgency.

Dinner

- Be respectful of the parents and volunteers serving you – SAY THANK YOU.
- Remain calm during dinner – maintain a level of focus.
- Clean your area of the cafeteria – leave it completely spotless.
- Throw away all trash, even if it is not yours.

Inspection

- Be completely in uniform by inspection time. Make no alterations to the uniform.
- Be careful not to leave marks on the floor (marching shoes leave scuff marks).
- Have your duffle bag with your hat box inside.
- Have your instrument (except large instruments), flip folder, lyre, and all required music.

Bus

- Ride the bus on which you signed up. Do not ask to be switched to a different bus.
- Respect your chaperones and follow their directions implicitly.
- No loud, rude, or disrespectful behavior.

Stands

- Enter the stands quickly and orderly. Remain standing until asked to turn around.
- Remain in your hat (and gloves, gauntlets) until told to remove them.
- No food, candy, gum, or drinks (except water) are allowed in the stands.
- Remain with your section and be seated directly behind the person in front of you.

Halftime

- Move quickly to your respective warm-up area and be silent in the warm-up arcs.
- Stand at parade rest while the other band performs. Absolutely no talking.
- Be prepared to perform the fight song immediately after halftime.
- PABC will provide drinks and a snack after halftime. Please be careful not to spill on your uniform.
- We will line up and march back into the stands (similar to pre-game).

Post-Game

- Get dressed into full uniform before leaving the stands.
- For home games, form a block on the track so we can march out of the stadium.
- Load the buses as quickly as possible.
- Upon returning to the school, immediately change out of uniform. It is critical that you properly hang your uniform. LEAVE NO CLOTHES AT THE SCHOOL.
- Return to the band hall and await our post-game meeting. Attendance is required.
- All sections will clean their designated area and check out with a drum major before anyone will be dismissed.
- After-party location and directions will be announced after dismissal.
