Late registration and payment deadline is June 21st.

Refund Policy:

- Tuition is refundable if written notification is received on or before June 4th.
- A student who fails to appear the first day of camp, or who leaves after registering, will not receive a refund.
- All returned checks are subject to a \$40.00 handling fee.
- Late registration will take place the first day of camp. (Hawaiian Falls Ticket will not be ordered.)

Assessments Update:

1. Assessments consists of Operations Fee, Registration Fees, Instrument Rental Fees, and Trip Fees.
2. As 2010-2011 will be a local trip year, payment for the band trip will begin some time after August and will be due in several installments. The cost of the trip will be set by the Trip Coordinators.
3. Operations and Registration Fees for next 2010-2011 will be set over the summer. They are a function of how much money the band needs, the cost for actual items (such as shoes, gloves, etc), and PABC budget items (such as cold drinks that are provided to students at football games and competitions).
4. There may be increases in Operations and Registration Fees, but we do not expect the increases to be significant.
5. Forms will be prepared over the summer, will be emailed as attachments to parents before Registration (via webmaster), and will be available on the band website. There are different forms for Band and Colorguard.
6. 2010-2011 Operations, Registration, and Instrument Rental Fees are **due in full at Registration on Tuesday, August 17**. We accept cash, checks, and MasterCard or Visa. Both the band and the PABC need the funds to commence operations.
7. However, due to the prolonged problems with the economy, *for 2010-2011*, if any parents *cannot* pay the entire amount of the Operations and Registration Fees in August, then we will accept payment in three installments. **To take advantage of this option, at Registration we must receive cash, a check or a credit card authorization for one-third of the amount due for August payment. Also at Registration, we must receive post-dated checks or signed credit card authorizations for payments dated September 15 and October 15.** Receipt of these post-dated checks or credit card authorizations *will* be considered payment in full. This option should only be used by families that really need it.
8. Payment will be the first stop at Registration. **No items (t-shirts, shoes, gloves, lyres, etc.) will be issued to any students who have not paid in full, per paragraphs 6 or 7 above.** These items are *essential equipment* to march with the Mighty Mustang Band. **Therefore, students who do not pay Registration and Operations Fees in full will not have necessary items and will be unable to perform on the field.**
9. Michele will be sending out final statements, for the current school year, to everyone by email before June 30. Please look for the emails - They come from "**Pearce Area Band Club**" (*not* general1@pearceband.org) and have an attachment called **Invoice** from Pearce Area Band Club. Almost everyone will have a zero balance.
10. Please **note if your child has a credit balance.** This amount should be deducted from your payment for Operations and Registrations Fees in August. Assessments volunteers at Registration will have a list of students, with credit balances noted. Senior students with credit balances have already either received reimbursement of overpayment, have donated their overpayment to the band, or have had a younger sibling in the band credited with the amount.

Thank you to everyone for having made this Assessments year successful. It has been a pleasure working with you. The 2010-2011 Assessments Directors for the PABC are Connie Shook and Glen McGee.
